Healthy Start Scheme

Esther and Caroline presented an overview of Healthy Start which offers milk, fruit and veg to adults during and post pregnancy and to their children. Vouchers are exchanged for foods. Uptake for this part of the scheme is good but the scheme also aims to improve health and development by offering free vitamins – around 3% of users access these.

Pharmacy could promote by targeting mums they know/expecting/buying formula/HLP health zone etc

Midwives are planning a pilot to provide vits for women from 8th week of pregnancy -> 8 weeks post birth to encourage longer-term use for both mum and infant, supported by PH campaign, social media

Eligible patients are being switched from Tiotropium to Braltus – support welcomed – explanation, MUR.NMS, advising patients on change. Practices using RxRHS for alert messages.
